The 2011 Bobbie Steen Awards will be presented on February 24th, 2011 in conjunction with the Sport BC Presidents' Awards at the River Rock Casino in Richmond.

There are 3 Bobbie Steen Awards:

- **The Bobbie Steen Legacy Foundation** (\$1000) is given to an emerging leader whose dedication to the women and girls of BC parallels those of Bobbie Steen and the Foundation. The award and funds will be given to support the education of an emerging leader or to support specific programming which champions gender equity in sport.
- **The Bobbie Steen Award of Excellence for Development** (\$1000) is given to an individual or organization to develop a new or enhance an existing program or to support professional development which champions women or gender equity in the area of sport and physical activity.
- **The Bobbie Steen Award of Excellence for Career Achievement** recognizes the achievements of an outstanding role model (individual or organization) who has, over the course of their career championed women or gender equity in the area of sport and physical activity.
